From member (1) Meetings should not occur in Alameda Country, a "Violation of or failure to comply with this Order is a misdemeanor punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both." from http://www.acgov.org/documents/Final-Order-to-Shelter-In-Place.pdf

From member (2) Twelve step meetings may have health/mental health reasons to meet.

From member (3) Personally, I am isolating as much as possible. Groups are using remote and virtual means as much as possible. Those new to the program or new to recovery benefit from direct communication and so in my view have a mental health reason to maintain social distances but still be present or social. Same with sponsor:sponsee interaction. Sometimes that interaction is appropriately virtual or electronic, sometimes human presence is needed for the health of those involved. I leave it to the conscience and best practices of those involved.

From member (4) Al-Anon saved my life. The steps kept me from suicide. The traditions kept me from homicide. Meetings help me return to sanity.

From member (5) Daily reading of program literature has been very useful in these early days of quarantine.

Al-Anon does not have spokespersons, does not govern, does not have rules. It only asks for "obedience to the unenforceable" in following our traditions in creating the greatest good for the greatest number.
