

District News - Coordinators Wanted!

The four Officers for the incoming panel have been elected. Ruby District Rep, Liz Assistant District Rep, CJ Treasurer, and Gregg Secretary are hoping to be joined by Coordinators for vacant positions.

Coordinators do NOT need to have Group Rep experience. Support of a Service Sponsor or coach is available!

Office Coordinator - with help from our experienced office part-timers, help keep the office open and help grow our list of volunteers.

Answering Service Coordinator - grow the Phone Answering Group of people who, from home, answer the phones when people with questions call the district. Coordinate the 2 hour training for new Answering Volunteers.

Literature Distribution Center - coordinate the volunteers, literature ordering, storage, bookkeeping, and outreach. This is essentially running a small business, including sales tax payments and filing monthly reports with the district. Help and coaching available!

Monthly Fellowship Event Coordinator - keep track of sponsoring groups for the monthly fellowship, provide guidance, the announcement template, Alateen and AA contact numbers to the sponsoring groups, make sure zoom information goes to the sponsoring groups and website and newsletter coordinator. This is one of the more social coordinator positions. Few hours per month required and very appreciated by the fellowship.

Newsletter Coordinator - keep track of developments in the district and publish a newsletter regularly. Currently we have 300+ people who subscribe. Some group reps print the pdf form of the newsletter for their group, some may even re-distribute it, so you will have a readership!

Public Information Coordinator - recruit table volunteers and coordinate literature availability for outreach events, health fairs, and festivals that welcome 12 step groups. Sometimes 2000 contacts made in a weekend! Past coordinators had fun and are available to coach! Usually a "fair weather" activity.

Insurance Coordinator - make sure groups and special events that need insurance forms for their host organization get them from the insurance company. Make sure the insurance company has a list of groups (?)

Institutions Coordinator - work with NCWSA to provide service not just to prisons and jails but to residential recovery programs. Recruit helpers when needs are identified.

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Phone Answering

Do you have a couple hours a week when you could answer the occasional phone call to the district? People call the district office for advice, information on meetings, literature, and office hours. Volunteers provide that service. No, you don't have to be working your twelfth step yet. You don't have to come in to the office. We have now figured out how to get the phone calls transferred to your phone for that two hour period. To assure you are successful and helpful, training will be arranged. Let you group rep or the office know (510) 276-2270. Thank you!
